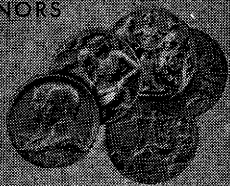


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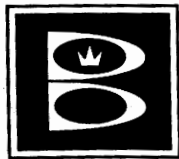
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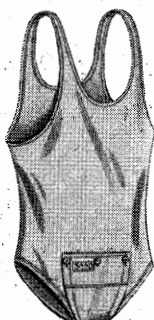
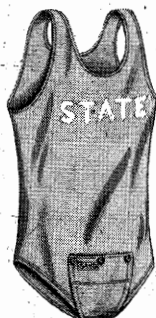




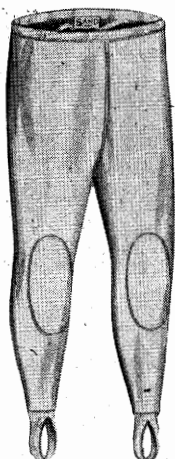
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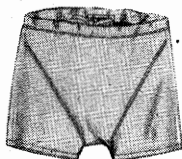


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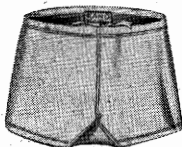
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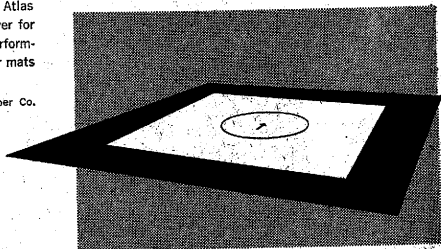
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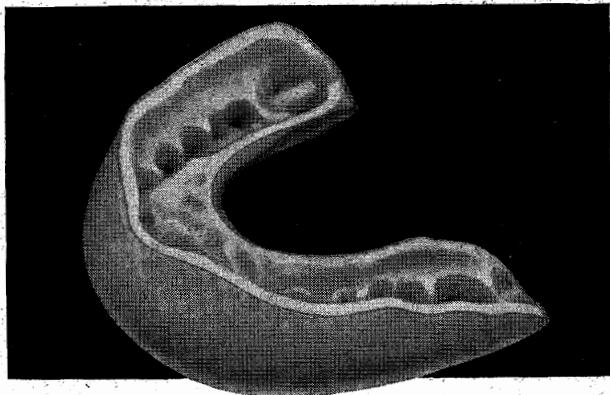


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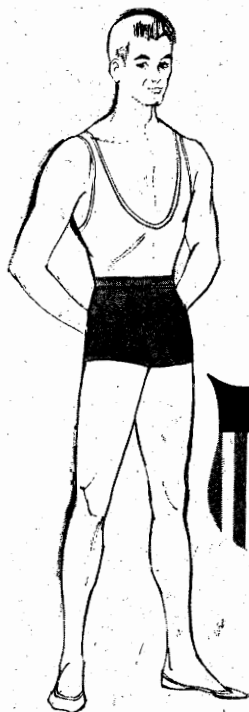
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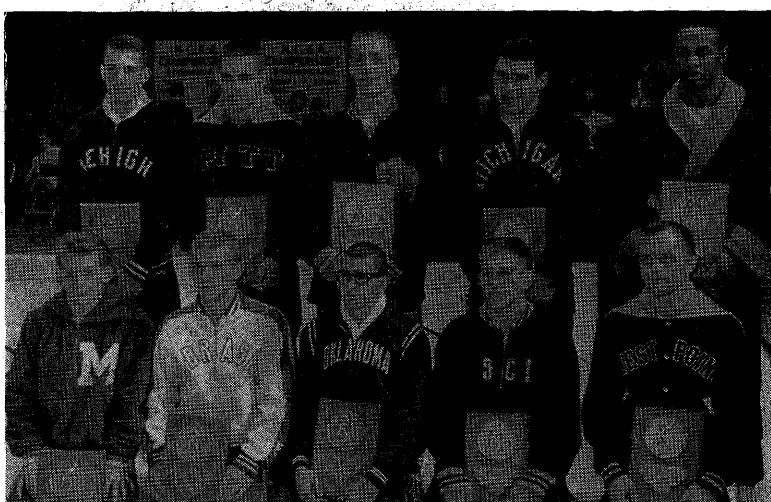

National Collegiate Championships

The University of Oklahoma Sooners captured their sixth team title in the 33rd National Collegiate Wrestling Tournament held at Kent State's Memorial Gymnasium. The Sooners took the title with 48 points, the lowest total for a championship equaled in eight years.

Iowa State University continued to be brides maids of the tourney as it took second with 45 points. The three-point difference was the closest the first and second place teams finished in the last seven seasons.

Big Eight schools dominated the first two spots as usual, but Eastern and Big Ten colleges edged closer to the top. Michigan took third with 36 points, as Pittsburgh, Syracuse and Oklahoma State tied for fourth.

Although the College-Division of the NCAA held a qualifying tournament the week prior to the nationals, the entry field topped the previous high mark, as 238 of the 267 entrants saw action in the tourney.

Mickey Martin of the champion Sooners took the 130-pound title for the second straight year and Army's Mike Natvig was successful in defending his 147-pound crown. Oklahoma's Wayne Baughman settled for runner-up spot when Michigan's Jack Barden unseated the 191-pound class champ.

Martin also followed in his father's footsteps when he was named the meet's Outstanding Wrestler, an award his dad won in 1936.

UCLA's Rahim Javinmard won the trophy for the most falls as he finished fourth in his 157-pound division.

No college was able to place more than one individual champion. Other national titles went to Bucky Maughan, Moorhead State, at 115 pounds; Mike Nissen, Nebraska, 123 pounds; Bill Dotson, Iowa State College, 137 pounds; Kirk Pendleton, Lehigh, 157 pounds; Jim Harrison, Pittsburgh, 167 pounds; Dean Lahr, Colorado, 177 pounds, and Jim Nance, Syracuse, at heavyweight.

The 1963 tournament also drew more than 15,000 spectators for the three days of wrestling. Officials, participating coaches and wrestlers considered the tourney "the finest NCAA tournament ever held." The tournament also enjoyed its first national television audience as the American Broadcasting Company brought the event to the home viewers.

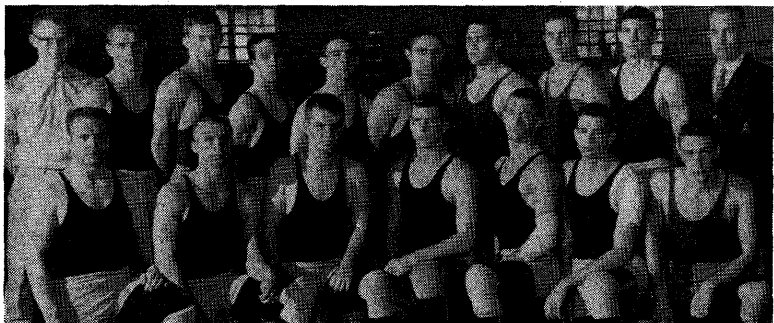

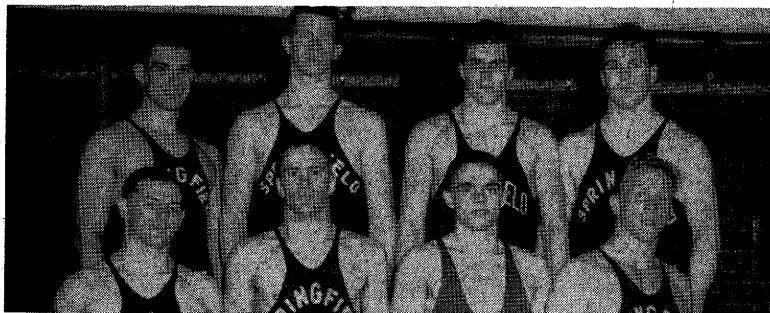

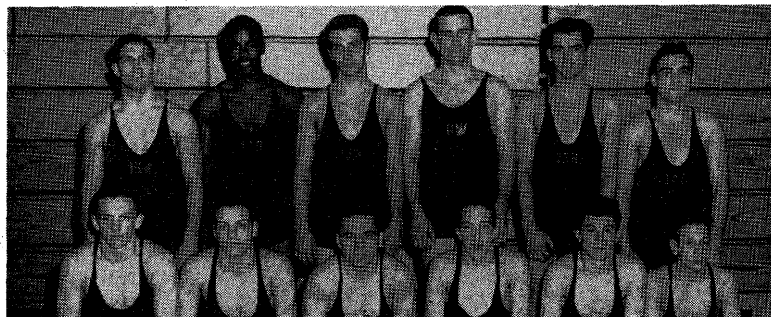

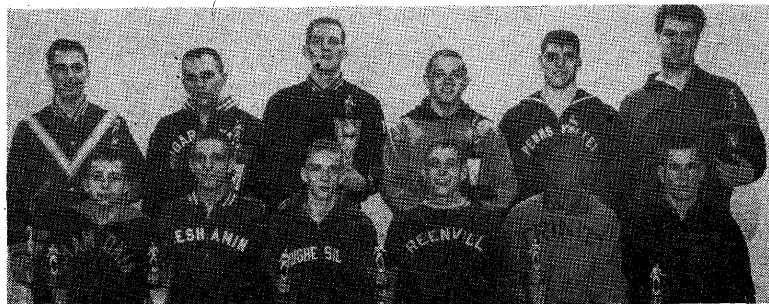
